

Tree Recording Sheet

Can you help the Cobble Hill Tree Fund? We are collecting information on the trees in the neighborhood. With this information we can take better care of the trees. To help us you are going to look at the tree closest to your home. With an adult fill out this sheet and return it to your teacher. Thanks for being a local scientist!

You will need:

- 1 measuring tape, 1 pencil, 1 recording sheet



Steps to measure your trees:

1. First find the tree and write the address of the building that it is in front of in the table below.
2. Now you are going to measure how big the tree is. Follow the steps below to measure the tree.

Step 1: Wrap the measuring tape around the tree at your eye level to see how big around the tree is. Make sure to measure in inches.

Step 2: Write the number in inches in the table below.



3. What kind of tree do you think it is? Use your tree booklet to see if you can identify the tree and write your idea in the table below. To help you identify the tree here are some things to think about:



→What is the shape of the leaves? →Is there any fruit on the tree?
